
## Login to device

User name: admin Password: admin01







#### Hardware installation

1. Pull out SIM holder by pushing the button and insert SIM cards which was given by your ISP (Internet Service Provider). Correct SIM card's orientation is shown in the picture.



- 2. Attach LTE antennas.
- 3. Connect the power adapter to the socket on the back of the device. Then plug the other end of the power adapter in to the power socket (or by your option).
- 4. Connect to the device wirelessly (SSID: rut850).

# Configure your computer (using Windows 7)
